### New Service Information Nomenclature

The layout of our Service Information for customers has changed. Together with this new layout we would like to present the new Service Information nomenclature.

Contrary to the previous practice of numbering (number / code year, e.g. No. 03/09) and indicating the affected engine type a consecutive numerical order will now be used for each engine type in combination with a code denoting the corresponding engine type (e.g. No. 0001 M43). This measure will help the engine operator to make sure that he has all Service Information documents relevant to the respective engine type. If, e.g. due to the fact that the last relevant Service Information was published a long time ago, an operator is uncertain as to whether he really has the complete set of documents, the responsible dealer will be in a position to clarify this at short notice. A request form for this purpose will be provided at our Internet site (<http://marine.cat.com/>) at short notice.

The following table shows examples of the new nomenclature with reference to the corresponding engine types. Besides the engine specific series there is also a sequence of numbers for general service information applying to all engine types. The numbers of this series are followed by the code "com" which stands for "common".

If a Service Information does not apply to all series of an engine type (e.g. applicable to M 43 C only and not to M 43) this is indicated in the right lower corner of the header. There the affected series are indicated after the words "Engine type:".
